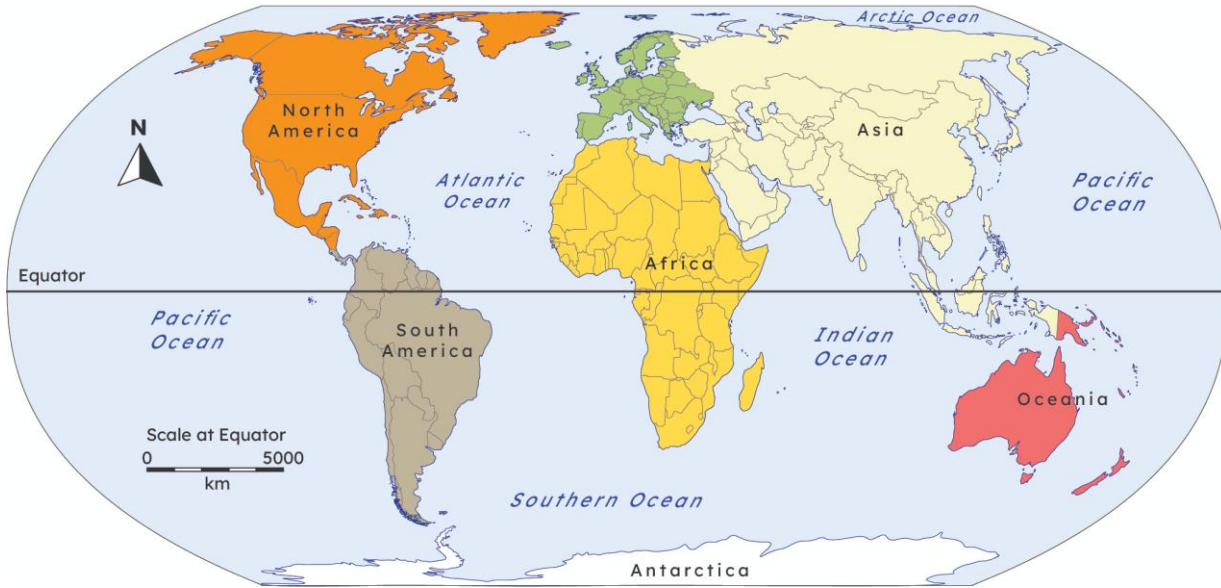


What will we see when we explore the world?

Glossary

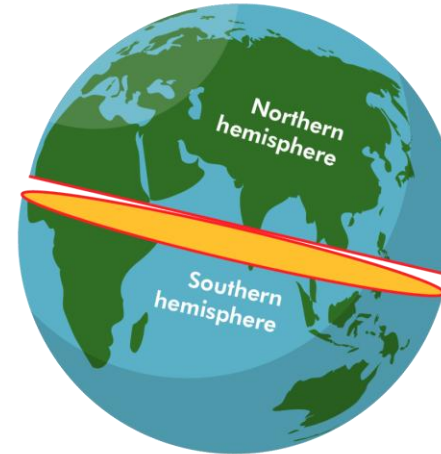
- Astronaut:** A space traveller.
- Circumnavigate:** To travel all the way around something.
- Climate:** The weather conditions.
- Continent:** A continuous expanse of land made from a group of countries.
- Curious:** Being keen to find things out or discover new things.
- Equator:** An invisible line around the middle of the Earth, dividing it into two distinct parts.
- Equipment:** Things made or used for a particular purpose.
- Explorer:** A person who explores a new or unfamiliar place.
- Ocean:** A very large expanse of sea.
- Hemisphere:** Half of the Earth
- Polar:** Relating to one of the poles (e.g. North Pole and South Pole).
- Trade:** The act of exchanging or buying and selling goods.
