- A number represents how many or how much
- One object is represented by the numeral 1, two objects are represented by the numeral 2, three objects are represented by the numeral 3, four objects are represented by the numeral 4 and five objects are represented by the numeral 5
- The last number reached when counting tells you how many there are in total
